Many times when you have a problem, you will find someone in the chapter has already incurred the same problem and may know of a quick economical fix. Often times, conversations under the shade tree center around motorhome problems and maintenance. Whether it relates to repairs, battery care, winterizing, tires, or use of various RV products & accessories, there is a wealth of information to be exchanged.

Newsletters and Staying Informed: With the Georgia Mountaineers having a rally almost every month, you stay informed of Chapter and FMCA events. Our newsletter, The Mountaineer, is published after each local rally. So if you miss a rally, you can catch up from the newsletter. Also, each chapter has an elected National Director who attends the FMCA Area and International meetings. Not only does he or she represent our chapter as a voting member at those meetings, but keeps our membership informed as to FMCA business, events, and directions. Plus, our website http://www.georgiamountaineers.org contains a wealth of information. It includes our Rally Schedules, newsletters, governing documents; and, on the Members Area a complete chapter Directory of our members, photo galleries, and other pertinent chapter information.

Involvement: The opportunity to become involved is another great benefit of chapter membership. Each rally has Rally Hosts who plan and execute the Rally Agenda. Normally, different members serve as Rally Hosts each month. More senior members, who have served as Rally Hosts in the past, help newer members by having them serve as cohosts with them. Also, the chapter does not run by itself. It takes a slate of elected and volunteer officers. Nothing is more rewarding than serving your chapter in one of the officer positions. Being involved gives you a sense of pride and purpose.

Broaden Perspectives: Another benefit of belonging to an FMCA chapter is the opportunity to learn different perspectives about the motorhome lifestyle. When you begin to hear how other people use their coaches and listen to them talk about their travels, a whole new world opens up before your eyes. Whether they were staying in nice RV parks, back woods campgrounds, or boon docking, motorhome owners love to share their experiences gladly tell you about places they have been, many of which you may never have thought of visiting. Many members have made extended travels all over the USA and Canada, and can provide helpful pointers for use in planning your trips. Chapter rallies may be held in various places that are new to you. If you look at our past Rally Schedules, you will see the Georgia Mountaineers have visited Alabama, Florida, Kentucky, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, and various destinations in Georgia.

Friends and Fellowship: This is probably the greatest benefit of all. Chapter rallies provide a great way to meet other folks who have the same interest as you do. The various rally agendas include activities, e.g., pot luck dinners, eating out, campfires, games, & tours, that give you the chance to interact with other members. Not only is it fun, you will have the opportunity to build lifetime relationships and friends. Our chapter has a Sunshine Reporter to keep us informed of members who have had illnesses, injuries, or deaths in the family. Our members truly care about one another.
